We are pleased to formally announce the Cabin Insurance Program for Recreation Residences!

Dear Tract Leader,

Due to anticipated high demand, we are rolling out the new NFH-endorsed cabin insurance program by communicating the announcement in phases. We are asking that tract leaders forward this message on to your members.

We want to **emphasize** that our initial focus will be on those cabin owners who have no current coverage or the greatest need, such as a notice of non-renewal, and urge them to apply soon. If you are satisfied with your current insurance, but looking at other options, you may find that is your best option. However, new carriers are coming on as the program evolves.

Members in your tract may apply for either **comprehensive cabin insurance - including property replacement and liability coverage** for their cabins or apply for **personal liability only**. Please note:

1. **Two insurance options/two applications.** There are two applications available on the ARM agency's website: one for full coverage and one for personal liability only. The latter is simpler.
2. **Personal liability is easiest to quote and obtain.** Personal liability prices are set by state, so ARM can provide quotes and proposals for this option, and your coverage can be obtained very quickly.
3. **Patience with high demand.** As we're rolling out this insurance program to our members, we would ask for extra patience -

depending on the applicant demand.

4. **Member-only program.** Members of NFH can apply and bind policies with the agency; however, non-members may receive quotes but must become NFH members to participate in a policy.

Please feel free to contact me if someone has a high need, or direct them to this link. Each applicant will fill out a few fields on the NFH web page form, then link to the ARM Cabin insurance for Recreation Residences page where you can download an application, fill it out and send it in for consideration. We hope to reach those with need or who are extremely unsatisfied with their current coverage.
