However, please review the following sentence in the draft proposal.

"Please note that these are my original thoughts, reviewed by a few select persons but not authorized by either the Friends of Pinecrest or the Pinecrest Permittees Association."

I think that once it is vetted by those to whom it was sent and then modified, corrected, changed, it would be sent to all FOP Board members for their comments etc. I am not prepared at this time to seek major circulation of the 'draft proposal'. However I did indeed say; *"While these are my thoughts, the FOP Board meeting the night before the TCPP meeting may bring up other ideas."* The next TCPP meeting is currently scheduled for November 12th, which should provide enough time for submittal and review of the requested input.
