The Pinecrest Permittees Association is a non-profit service district serving a community in the Stanislaus National Forest, 30 miles northeast of Sonora on Highway 108 at 5600' elevation. Pinecrest is a year-round resort area adjoining Pinecrest Lake with recreational boating, fishing, biking, hiking, Nordic & downhill skiing.

The Association provides water & wastewater services, solid waste collection and maintenance of approximately 5 miles of roads serving 383 private recreation residences, commercial areas and public camps who are members of the Association & the US Forest Service. The Association also operates the Pinecrest Fire Station in co-operation with the Tuolumne County Fire Department.

The Association is managed by an eleven member Board of Directors elected by the membership. The Board is headed by a president who serves as the CEO.

Applicants should have a minimum of 5 years experience in water & wastewater operations & be familiar with California regulations, ideally possessing D-2 & T-2& W-2 certifications. Be willing to join Volunteer fire department

Applicants should have an understanding of fiscal accounting, personnel management, basic computer skills & the ability to deal with the public and a variety of outside agencies like the US Forest Service, State of California & County of Tuolumne.
